<b>Illustration Station</b>	Become an illustrator: Create a new illustration for a page in a book you are reading or your favourite scene in a book.	Mini-art: Can you fit the front cover of your favourite book clearly inside the space of a 2p coin? 	Through the keyhole: Choose a room that your character visits in your book. Imagine you peeked through the keyhole in the door of that room. Draw what you would see in the keyhole. 
<b>Re-create it</b>	Re-create the book cover. Use yourself and family members as characters, stuffed teddys, Lego figures, dolls or even pets.	Act out your favourite part of your favourite book. Think about how the characters might talk and their actions and facial expressions.	Dress a potato to look like your favourite book character. 
<b>Read all about it</b>	Read a piece of work you have written this week out loud. Practise your fluency and expression.	Hide the front of the book and read the blurb (the back of the book) blanking out any character names. Can family members guess which book it is? (A video could be uploaded to Google Classroom for the class to guess.)	Echo reading: Ask a member of your family to read a story, a sentence at a time, and you echo it back. Copy the adult's tone, expression, pace and even funny voices. If you have an older sibling, they could read and you can echo.
<b>Think Outside the Book (for Key Stage 2)</b>	Imagine you had £10 to spend on a character in the book you are reading. What gift would you buy them and why? It could be something that would help them in the story on their journey. It could be something you think they would love because of their personality.	If a story character went on holiday, what would be their main items they would pack? Why? What would they not be able to live without while they were away?	If you were having a birthday party, which book characters would you invite and why? You can invite 5 characters. Are there any characters that would get along well with each other or would they clash?
