

## English

**Narrative** - This term the children will be writing their own narrative from a different perspective based on the book 'The Journey' by Aaron Becker.

**Non Fiction**— This term the children will also be creating a leaflet providing information on Anglo-Saxons which is linked to our topic this term.

## Science

**Autumn 1:** Our science topic this term is States of Matter. During this unit, children will compare and group materials together according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. Children will observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled and will measure, research and investigate the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C). During this time, children will identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.

## Maths

## 'To live like an Anglo-Saxon'

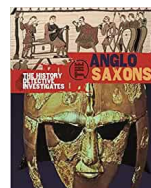
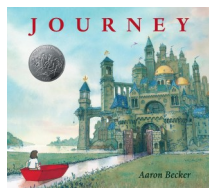
### Rationale, Hook and Final Celebration:

**Rationale:** The rationale behind teaching about the Anglo-Saxons is to improve their knowledge and understanding chronologically of world History, for them to note connections and contrasts over time periods and for them to understand that different versions of the past may exist and for them to have an understanding of why this may happen.

**Hook:** Children be given to opportunity to create a 'royal bread recipe' and a 'peasant bread recipe'. Here they will be able to see and taste the difference of both and understand how there was a hierarchy within Anglo-Saxon society.

**Final Celebrations:** Children will showcase their learning and understanding through a class assembly on what they have learned.

## RE

### **Autumn 1:**

- The theme this term is Spiritual Expression.
- Within this topic, children will learn and discuss how Christians practice their faith and express themselves through the use of music.
- Children will also look at the deeper meanings to how they worship and what their views are.

### Art:

**Autumn 1:** This half term we will be doing an Art topic. We are looking at Drawing: Power prints.

## History

- They will examine and compare artefacts to allow them to understand how old they actually are.
- Children will also discuss historical changes in Britain, what caused them and the impact on life in Britain.
