English

Narrative - This term the children will be writing their own narrative based on the short animation 'The present' by Jane Considine. We will be looking at the how we can use the Year 5 writing objectives in our independent writing.

Non Fiction— Also this term the children will also be writing a persuasive letter about deforestation - Major environmental problems.

<u>Science</u>

Autumn 1: Space

For the next term in Year 5 we will be looking at space. We will be learning about the Earth and it's place in the solar system. The children will also be able to name the plants and explain how they orbit the sun. We will make predictions about night and day in different places on Earth.

Maths

At Snape Wood, we follow the White Rose approach.

In Autumn 1, the children will focus on:

- Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction

'To infinity and beyond' Rationale, Hook and Final Celebration:

Rationale: The rationale behind teaching about Earth and Space is for children to be able to understand about the relative movement, shapes and sizes of the Earth, Sun and Moon. They will also learn about the rest of the solar system and human's exploration of space.

Hook: Children be given to opportunity to create a 'solar system' and a 'to design a new outfit for an Astronaut'. Here they will be able to have a clear picture of the importance of the solar system, the origin and evolution of planets, along with the conditions necessary for life.

Final Celebrations: Children will showcase their learning and understanding through a class assembly on what they have learned.
