Science

Autumn 2: Our science topic this term is Sound. During this unit, children will be able to identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating. They will recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear. Through investigations, they will find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it. Here they will find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it.

'Rivers and the Water Cycle'

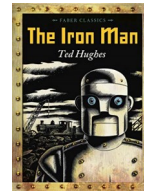
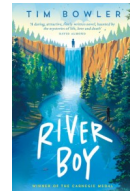
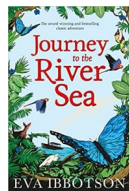
Rationale, Hook and Final Celebration:
