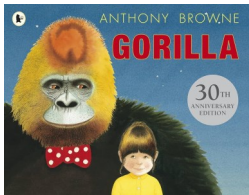


English

'Biomes'

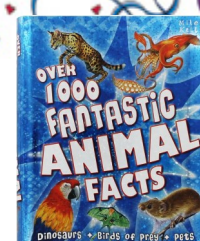
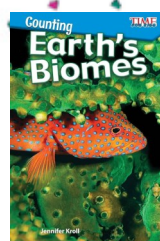
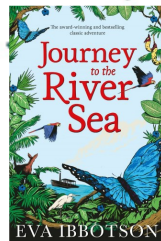
Rationale, Hook and Final Celebration:
