'The Anglo-Saxon and Viking Conflict '

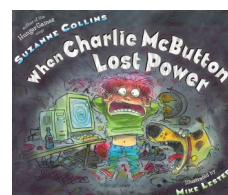
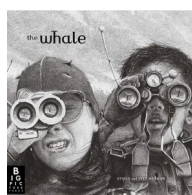
Rationale, Hook and Final Celebration:
