Roman Britain

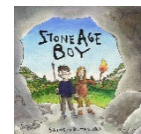
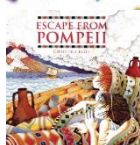
Rationale, Hook and Final Celebration:

Snap Wood PRIDE and the World (PSHE)

Children will be focussing on the PRIDE values of Positive Respect, being Inquisitive and showing Empathy. We will discuss how important it is to be inquisitive about the world around us and through gaining an understanding of how our world works and the people in it, then we can show Empathy through our actions and the decisions that we made. A key PRIDE value throughout this term will be Empathy. Within PSHE we will be exploring rights and responsibilities which will involve looking at how we can be good people within society.
