'Crime and Punishment'

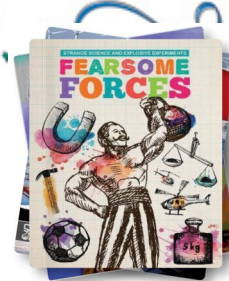
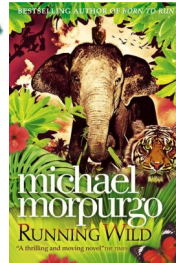
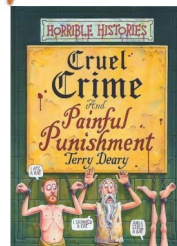
Rationale, Hook and Final Celebration:
