We will be learning about search engines.

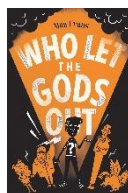
Ancient Greece

Rationale, Hook and Final Celebration:

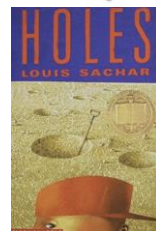
Rationale: We will be learning about Ancient Greece because it informs us of the origins of many practices of daily life.
