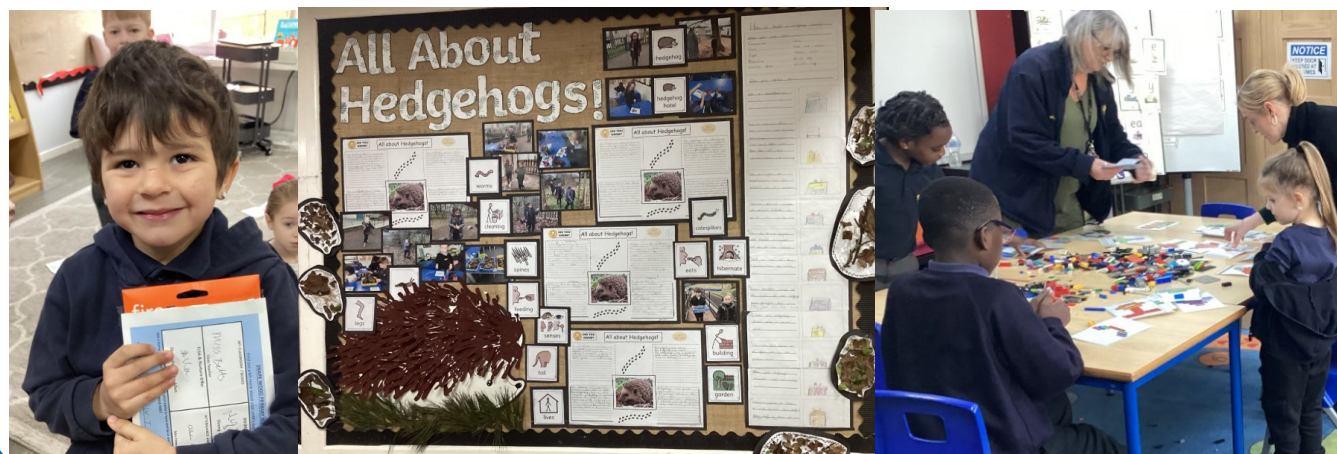


**Lego After School Club!**

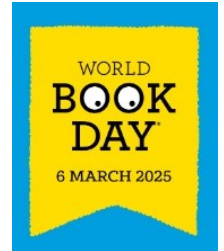


# Key Dates for Parents
