No Nonsense Phonics Skills

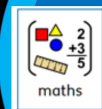
WRITING!

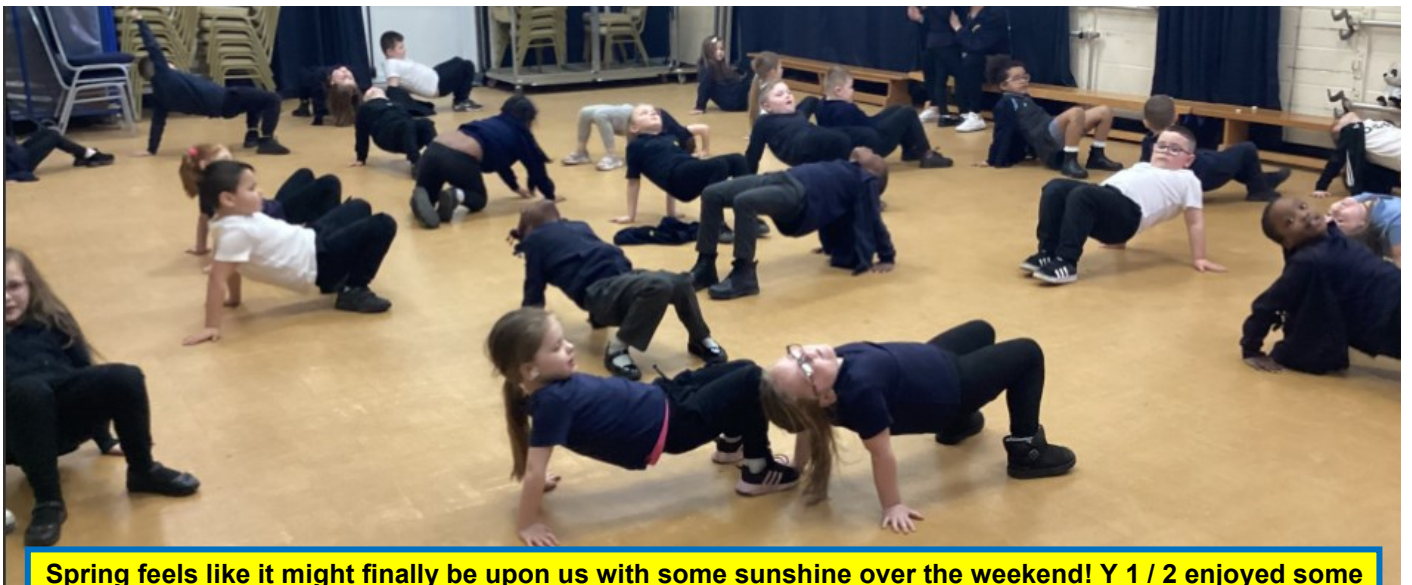
