What is Safeguarding?

At Snape Wood Primary School, all of the adults think that your health, safety and wellbeing are very important. We **respect** you and want to keep you safe.

We do our best to help you to make good progress in your learning, and to be happy when you are in school.

We teach you how to recognise risks, how to stay safe and about respect.

All children and adults at Snape Wood Primary School have the right to feel **safe and happy**.

How will we try to protect you?

😊 We try to provide a **safe** environment for you to learn in.

😊 We want to make sure you are safe, at home as well as in school.

😊 **If you need to talk, we will listen.**

We think it is important for you to know where to get help.

Tell someone if someone is:

😞 Bullying you, remember bullying is when someone is unkind Several Times On Purpose (**STOP**).

😞 Saying things to you that upset you or make you feel uncomfortable. "**SAY NO... GO TELL!**"

Touching you in a way that makes you feel uncomfortable.

😞 Hitting you or hurting you.

😞 Taking your things.

😞 Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone.



Who can you talk to?

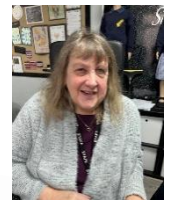
